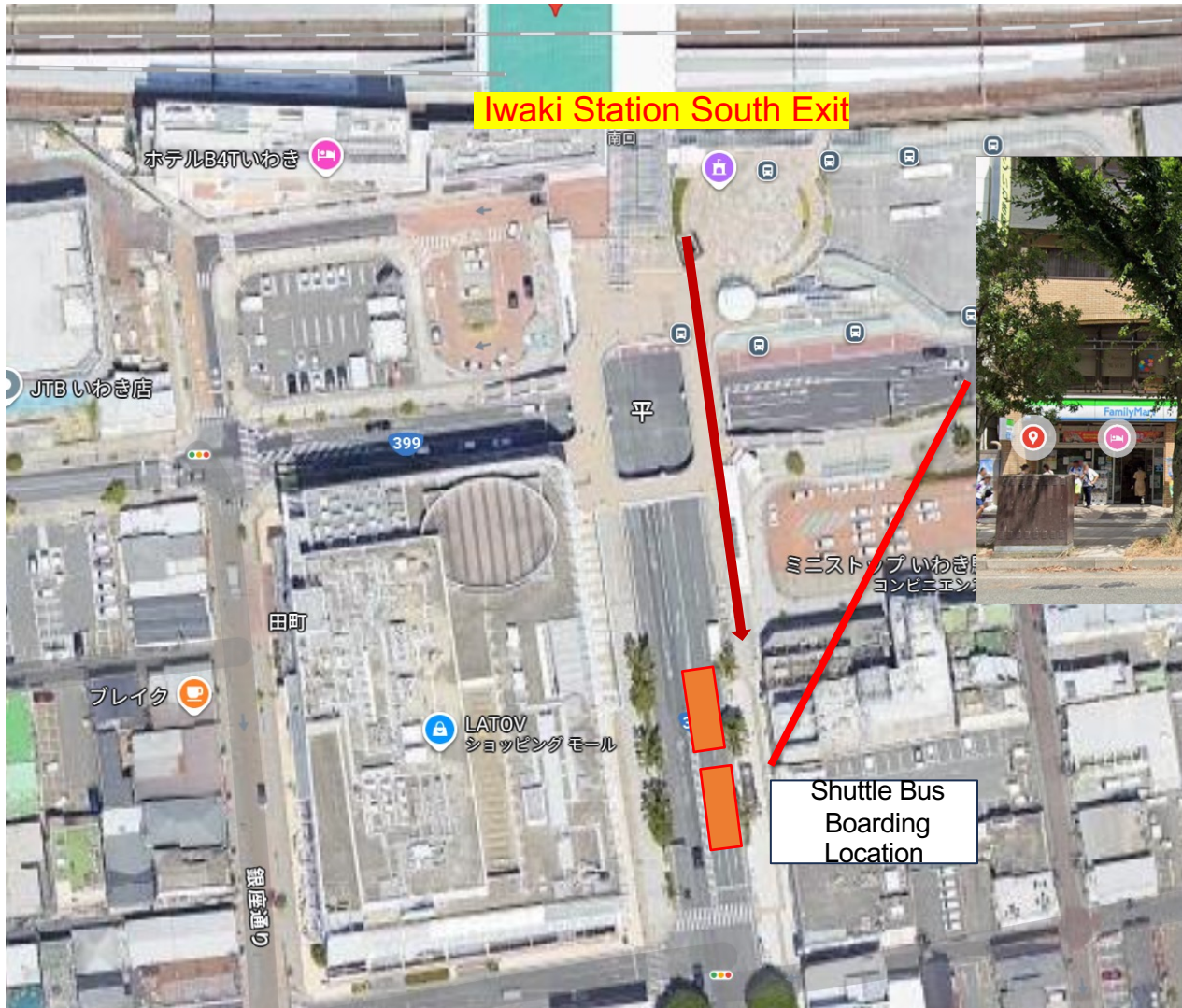

Iwaki Station Shuttle Bus Departure and Arrival Locations

The shuttle bus from Iwaki Station will depart from and arrive at the following shuttle bus stop.
Please gather at this boarding location prior to departure time.



The bus departs from the bus stop in front of Family Mart.

Venue Shuttle Bus and Microbus Departure and Arrival Locations

As it is not possible to directly enter the convention site, the buses will depart from and arrive at the J-Village central roundabout a short distance ahead of the convention site.

Since it is difficult to provide a place for loading and unloading luggage, we ask that you bring as little luggage as possible to the venue. Also, please do not park your car on the road near the venue for loading and unloading luggage.

How to purchase a shuttle bus from Iwaki Station to the venue



Numbered shuttle bus tickets will be available at LivePocket from 20:00 on 10/5 (Sun.)

Tickets will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis.

Parking tickets are free of charge (tickets will be sold for 0 yen).

Tickets will be available for the following types of rides, depending on the day and time of the day and time of day.

Please note that **you can only ride the bus on the day/time you purchased!**

If you wish to use the bus on the first and second day of the convention (both days), please purchase a numbered ticket for both days.

If you are planning to ride on the bus on both days, please purchase numbered tickets for both days.

Buses from the venue to Iwaki Station on the way home do not require a numbered ticket.

How to generate Livepocket QR Code

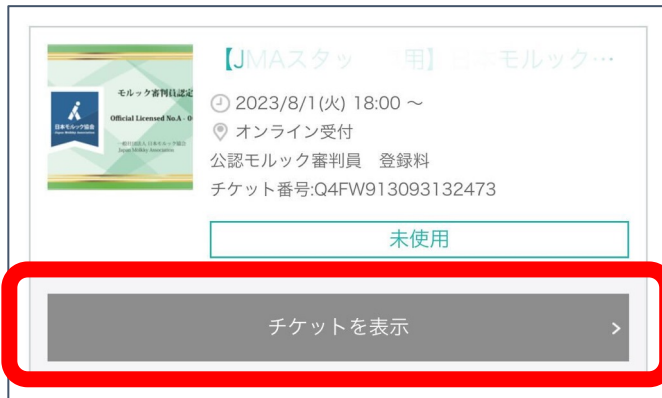


Click on the URL in the email that you received after your purchase is complete, and you will see the screen as below①.
